NOTICE OF RACE

Introduction: The newly formed Osprey Sail Team would like to welcome fellow youth sailors to our first open regatta. This is a low-key event focusing on fun and learning for sailors ages 11-17. Welcome to our home in Knoxville, TN.

Organizing Authority: Concord Sailing Center

Rules: The Cinco de Mayo Regatta will be conducted in accordance with the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), latest edition, and the US Sailing Prescriptions (USSP), as modified by the Sailing Instructions (SI). Full details of rules changes will be provided in the SI. This will include RRS 77 and 78 covering sail numbers and class rules. The SI may also change other racing rules.

Sailing Instructions will be available prior to the event on the web site and at the onsite registration.

Eligibility: All races are open to youths ages 11-17. The regatta is open to boats of the O'Pen Bic and Fusion classes equipped with standard equipment. Fusion class will be sailed without spinnaker, but may be single- or double-handed, with or without jib.

Registration: Registration may be made through the CYC web page. The cost of registration is \$20. This includes Saturday lunch and dinner for the competitor. Additional meal packages can be purchased for \$10 each. See link below.

Fleets: Competitors are encouraged to bring their own boats if possible. A limited number of boats will be available on a first-come first-served basis. If the number of competitors exceeds the number of available boats, the Organizing Authority reserves the right to establish rotations, or to add or substitute C420s as a fleet.

Schedule: Races are scheduled for Saturday afternoon.

Saturday

- 1000h – Onsite registration opens
- 1200h – Competitors meeting
- 1300h – First warning signal
- 1630h – Time limit for start of final race
- 1730h – Party on the patio

Courses: Races will be sailed on Fort Loudoun Lake, in the general vicinity of Concord Yacht Club, between mile markers 615.7 and 617.7. Courses will be detailed in the SI and described at the Competitors' Meeting.

Scoring & Awards: A low point scoring system will be used in accordance with Appendix A of the RRS. All races will count towards the final score. Completion of one race will constitute a Regatta. Awards will be made to the first three places in each fleet.

Liability: Competitors participate in this regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS #4, Decision to Race. CSC/CYC will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during, or after the Regatta.

Media Rights: By participating in this Regatta, a competitor (or parent/guardian if under age 18) grants to the Organizing Authority the right in perpetuity to make, use and show, from time to time at their discretion, any photographs, motion pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of him or her during the period of the competition without compensation.
